# Welcome to the Peace River Regional District!

The Peace River Regional District (PRRD) was established in 1967, and is geographically the largest regional district in BC, encompassing over 119,000 kilometres.

A regional district provides regional and sub-regional services to in accordance with the *Local Government Act* and *Community Charter*, governed by a Regional Board of Directors who are elected from each electoral area, and elected council of each municipality.

The PRRD serves seven incorporated communities and four electoral areas that include 46 unincorporated (rural) communities. There are eight First Nations communities within the Regional District's boundaries, including the traditional lands of the McLeod Lake Indian Band.

## THE ALASKA HIGHWAY

### OUR HISTORY, OUR MAIN STREET

The Alaska Highway, formerly known as the Alcan (Alaska-Canadian) Highway, winds its way through wilderness connecting Dawson Creek, British Columbia and Fairbanks, Alaska.

Officially, the highway began on March 8, 1942 with a group starting north from Dawson Creek, then a small town of 600; the highway was completed eight months later on October 25, 1942.

More than 11,000 American troops, including 7 regiments of engineers, 16,000 civilian workmen from Canada and the United States and 7,000 pieces of equipment were thrown into the herculean task of penetrating the 1500 miles of mountains, muskeg and mosquitoes.

On September 28, 1996 at a ceremony in Dawson Creek, British Columbia, the Alaska Highway was designated as the 16th International Historical Civil Engineering Landmark.

The Alaska Highway today stands as the main street of the Peace Region, and our gateway to the northern frontiers.

#### A LAND RICH IN HISTORY & HERITAGE

The history of the Peace Region holds the treasures of the past and the keys to the future. There are many museums, archives, and historical societies to be explore throughout the Peace Region.

# THE NORTH IS OPEN FOR BUSINESS

## **Energy and natural resources are driving forces for both the local and provincial economy.**

Much of the province's electricity comes from the three hydro-electric dams on the Peace River. Companies have partnered with First Nations to embark on two new windfarms in the North Peace which will add additional, renewable energy to BC Hydro's grid.

These new wind projects join 3 other existing wind farms in the Peace Region.

**The petroleum industry has evolved from being mainly focussed on exploration to production,** and coupled with the bountiful natural gas supply found in the Montney Formation, has allowed the region to be at the forefront of the LNG industry. Through TC Energy's Coastal GasLink LNG project Shell Canada and Petronas gas is shipped to Kitimat via pipeline, destined for Asian markets, where they are replacing their coal-fired power with more emissions-friendly Canadian LNG.

The region is also an ideal location for Carbon Capture and Sequestration projects, with many companies, such as Shell Canada and Petronas, which operate in the North Peace taking advantage of an opportunity to make carbon reduction part of their operations.

**As the hub of the natural resource industry in BC, and the gateway to the vast resources of Northern BC and beyond, Fort St. John is also home to many different types of businesses that service local industry.** Firms in Fort St. John provide everything from roadbuilding and equipment hauling to well testing, pipeline drilling, environmental consultation and restoration.

Fort St. John began as the first trading post and white settlement in British Columbia and was originally called Rocky Mountain Fort when it was established in 1794. It grew with the gold rush and the construction of the Alaska Highway during World War II.

Expansion continued with the discovery of oil and natural gas, the development of a forest industry and continued growth of agriculture in the North Peace. As technology has improved, so have innovations in all industries that help reduce emissions while creating new industries focussing on expanding the availability of clean energy.

The growth in northeastern BC has continued, and Fort St. John is now a thriving city of over 21,000 people with a wide array of businesses, recreational and educational opportunities as well as the industries which support both the region and the province.



**With Conuma Resources reopening the Quintette mine in Tumbler Ridge,** the company will have four coal mines in the region which supply coal to the steel industry. These mines provide a variety of direct and indirect jobs to Chetwynd and Tumbler Ridge, in addition to other industry and agriculture areas surrounding these communities.

## The Peace Region is located on the traditional territory of the Dane-zaa First Nation peoples.

According to Dane-zaa oral history, the Peace River is named for the settling of a conflict between the Dane-zaa and the Cree. The Cree traditionally lived south and east of the Upper Peace River region. Due to their trade with settlers, they had guns and they pushed the Dane-zaa northwest in the late 18th century. A peace treaty, negotiated in the late 1700s or early 1800s, stated that the Cree would live south of the Peace River, and the Dane-zaa north. The Peace River, before and after its new name, marked a boundary zone, where groups met for trade, celebration, and settling of disputes.

Archaeological evidence at Charlie Lake Cave establishes that the area of Charlie Lake north of Fort St. John has been continuously occupied for 12,500 years by varying cultures of indigenous peoples.

The Dane-zaa of Fort St. John took an adhesion to Treaty 8 in 1900. Today they continue to have a strong cultural and economic presence in the North Peace area.

### The Peace Region is home to several First Nation communities, including:

- » Blueberry River First Nation
- » Doig River First Nation
- » Fort Nelson First Nation
- » West Moberly First Nations
- » Prophet River First Nation
- » Halfway River First Nation
- » Saulteau First Nation
- » Tsay Keh Dene Band

The ethno-linguistic grouping within these First Nations communities includes Sicannie (Sikanni), Slavey, Beaver (Dane-zaa), Cree, Saulteau and Dene.

On June 21, 1899, the eighth treaty between the Indigenous people of North America and the Queen of England was signed and would become known as the most comprehensive treaty in Canada.

The signatories of Treaty No. 8 agreed to the oral promises made during these negotiations and understood them as a partnership based on peace and friendship, a partnership that would create certainty for both parties, *"For as long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the rivers flow"*.

The Treaty 8 Tribal Association was incorporated in 1982 under the BC Societies Act and currently represents six of the First Nations in Northeastern BC. The Treaty 8 Tribal Association acts as a coordinator, facilitator, and technical support on various issues as mandated from time to time by the Council of Treaty 8 Chiefs.



## Tse'k'wa National Historic Site

Charlie Lake, BC



Tse'k'wa ("rock house" in Dane-zaa/Beaver language) is an important cultural site for the Dane-zaa people, dating back more than 12,500 years. Formerly known as the Charlie Lake Cave, it is now recognized as a National Historic Site for its cultural and archaeological significance. The site is owned and managed by the Tse'k'wa Heritage Society, a non-profit organization that is a collaboration of three First Nations: Doig River, Prophet River and West Moberly First Nations. Their shared vision is to share Dane-zaa culture, language, and heritage.

The Society continues to transform the site to welcome the public. Improvements include an interpretive trail to the cave, open air amphitheater, accessible picnic tables and outhouses, and an archaeology dome. Indoor interpretive experiences are planned for the future. The Society's goal is to create a world-class museum and interpretive centre connecting the past, present, and future.

Tse'k'wa Heritage Society invites you to enter a gathering space used by the Dane-zaa since the time of the wq̓lii nachíí (giant animals). Our cultural programming and public events will bring you on an exciting journey of shared history that builds respect for our land's First Peoples. # FORT ST. JOHN

**Fort St. John is a great place to visit and play, and offers a uniquely rich concentration of cultural activities and outdoor adventures. Fort St. John offers top-notch recreation facilities and being “The Energetic City”, has hundreds of events taking place every year that entertain people of all ages and interests.**

The City of Fort St. John is the largest community in northeastern British Columbia and the oldest non-First Nations settlement in British Columbia. Originally established in 1794 as Rocky Mountain Fort, today Fort St. John has a population of 21,123 and is growing strong. Fort St. John is not only the largest city in the Northeast Region of BC; it is also the largest city in British Columbia situated along the world-famous Alaska Highway.

Fort St. John is “The Energetic City” for good reason. The title reflects not only our large resource base of oil, natural gas, forestry and agriculture, but also the vitality of our residents who are, on average, 8.8 years younger than the average population in the rest of the province. Modern day pioneers continue to bring a fresh spirit of exploration, innovation and connection to community within our city.

Fort St. John is surrounded by wilderness which is home to some of the best hunting and fishing opportunities in North America. The City features excellent year-round sports facilities. From an arts and cultural perspective, Fort St. John is home to a growing arts scene and an ever-increasing diversity of ethnic groups,

resulting in a culturally diverse community. In addition, many festivals and events occur within and around Fort St. John.

Here, you can spend less time commuting and less money on housing, and more time on recreation and really living it up. The average house price is under \$400k and a two-bedroom apartment can be rented for around \$1,000 a month. Our standard of living is high: The median household income is \$107,000.



**The Festival Plaza is the centrepiece of downtown Fort St. John, providing an all-season venue for farmers markets, festivals, celebrations, concerts, and many other events.**

The Festival Plaza features a 7,000 square-foot structure for hosting events in all weather conditions. The building can accommodate up to 300 people during a variety of activities.

The plaza itself is well lit by warm and coloured LED lights, and is ringed by four large gas-fueled fire cauldrons decorated with local art reflecting the region and its peoples.

## DISTRICT OF **TAYLOR**

Housing options include residential subdivisions, trailer parks, lake front properties and rural residential farms. Many beautiful country residences surround the lake and the area has an affluent population.

Most of the business sector of Charlie Lake is situated on the south side of the lake along Highway 97 with a school, church, gas station, campgrounds and some residences. All other services are accessible nearby in Fort St. John.

Tumbler Ridge stands as the ultimate adventure destination in the Peace Region. With over 300 kilometres of trails covering a vast network of cutlines and forest roads, those seeking adventure can make Tumbler Ridge their base for hiking, biking, UTV's, and more.

Known as the Waterfall Capital of the North, mother nature has carved out dozens of waterfalls from roadside falls to secluded cascades. The most famous, Kinuseo Falls, which is taller than Niagara Falls (60 m) is located in breathtaking Monkman Provincial Park.

Tumbler Ridge is the ultimate destination for adventure in the Peace Region. Explore more than 300 kilometres of trails, roads and paths, or venture into the UNESCO Global Geopark - one of 5 geoparks in Canada, and the only one located in western North America.

**Hike the trails at the Fort St. John Fish Creek Community Forest, spot a variety of water birds at Charlie Lake during the spring migration period, boat and fish the area's vast network of waterways and lakes.**

The nearest rivers including, the Peace, Beatton, Moberly and Pine Rivers are great for boating, fishing and other water activities. Sweeping fields provide beautiful summer drives in the country, where ripe yellow canola and other seed crops grow.

Wander out to Montney Centennial Regional Park that is located at the northeast end of Charlie Lake, providing a rustic campground with a picnic area, a camping area, and access to the water that is off the beaten track. The park is free for public use. PRRD parks are generally open from May to September.

Bike paved trails around Fort St. John (also suited to leisurely strolls), or ride along quiet country roads that meander through agricultural lands and spectacular river valleys.

## WHAT IS A GEOPARK?

Geoparks are specially designated places that are recognized for their international geological significance by UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organizations). Our 34 accessible geosites include mountain peaks, alpine meadows, glaciers, canyons, waterfalls, incredible vistas, caves and karst formations, and dinosaur trackways and fossils. Significant new discoveries are found every year!

Unlike national or provincial parks, UNESCO Global Geoparks do not have additional restrictions outside of established laws on activities like resource extraction, hunting, or motorized recreation. Within our Geopark you will find everything from renewable energy wind farms, metallurgical coal mines and forestry operations to hiking trails, ATV and snowmobile terrain, river boating, snowshoe and cross country skiing trails, rock and ice climbing, and horseback riding trails.

Our mission is to honour the geological, cultural and environmental character of our Geopark, to enhance the well-being of our people through education, engagement and sustainable development. We also celebrate stories of people and place.

Tumbler Ridge UNESCO Global Geopark is one of only five Geoparks in Canada, and the only one located in western North America.





you will find exactly the artwork you will love to display to friends and family. From paintings to pottery and everything in between, local art abounds at the Gallery.





# education IN THE PEACE REGION

## **The Peace Region is rich in opportunities for students of all ages.**

In School District 60, which covers not only Fort St. John, but also the smaller outlying communities, serving residents with elementary schools or elementary-secondary schools if they are located too far from Fort St. John for daily busing.

Fort St. John itself has eight elementary schools, two middle schools and one secondary school. Two of the elementary schools are less than 6 years old, and Ma Murray Community School is also home to a YMCA-operated daycare centre. Distance education options are available at the Key Learning Centre, and a French Immersion program is available at Ecole Central Elementary and Bert Bowes Middle School.

School District 59 covers the City of Dawson Creek, District of Chetwynd, the District of Tumbler Ridge, and smaller surrounding communities.

Dawson Creek serves its residents with 10 elementary schools, a secondary school split into two separate campuses, and a distributed learning school. French Immersion programs are available at Ecole Franc Ross Elementary and Dawson Creek Secondary School.

Chetwynd has three elementary schools within the district, as well as the Chetwynd Secondary School, serving kindergarten to grade 12. Chetwynd is also home to the Don Titus Montessori school, offer a unique blend of the standard BC curriculum and the Montessori school of learning - created to deliver material in a manner designed to spark the imagination and foster independent learning.

Tumbler Ridge contains two public schools, as well as a Northern Lights College Campus. Because of the small population, students enjoy a tremendous sense of community, and graduate with strong and enduring relationships among staff and students. New students attending in Tumbler Ridge can look forward to personal attention, flexible timetables, unique learning experiences, and a variety of recreational opportunities.

Hudson's Hope serves its students with a single facility covering kindergarten to grade 12. The school is a central part of the community and provides a wide variety activities, equipment and facilities.

Northern Lights College provides a variety of educational programs, and in conjunction with regional school districts offers a dual credit program for high school students in a variety of trades. It is also home to several unique training programs developed specifically to allow northern residents to train at home.

Through the early 2000s, many additions were made to the college campus, including an Aboriginal Student Resource Centre, student housing and the Industry Training Centre/ Oil and Gas Training Centre further expanding educational opportunities.

The University of Northern British Columbia (UNBC) has their regional campus and largest regional service center in Fort St. John. UNBC offers an array of courses in the Peace River-Liard region, including undergraduate programs and university transfer course offerings in partnership with Northern Lights College.

# HEALTH & WELLNESS

**Northern Health offers services in over two dozen communities through 50 facilities and locations. The population of these communities ranges from a few hundred people to over 80,000 people.**

## Health Care Services

Health care services are managed by the Northeast Health Service Delivery Area of Northern Health. Residents in the North Peace of the Peace Region are served by staff that work both within and out of several health care facilities that include the Fort St. John Hospital and Peace Villa Long-term Care Facility, Fort St. John Health Unit, Mental Health and Substance Use program and the Hudson's Hope Health Centre, with services ranging from hospital to long term care to community services that include public health, home community care, mental health and substance use, harm reduction, and other programs and supports.

## Fort St. John Hospital

The Fort St. John Hospital and Peace Villa celebrated their 10th anniversary in 2022, as the first full hospital replacement of this size in the north. It provides area residents with state-of-the-art acute care facilities and an expanded new long-term care facility for local seniors and individuals with complex care needs. The hospital is approximately 23,353 square metres and includes 55 acute care beds. Health care services at the Fort St. John Hospital include: an expanded emergency room and ambulatory care department;

larger-sized and number of operating rooms; endoscopy suite within the surgical department; Birthing Centre includes Labour, Delivery, Recovery and Post-partum room all within single patient rooms; the majority of patient rooms are single Inpatient Rooms and there is an academic space for the Northern Medical Program and the NH Simulation Lab. The hospital also includes an array of services such as laboratory services that include the NE pathology and microbiology departments, full range of radiology including NE Nuclear Medicine, ultrasound, CT scan and a MRI.

## Peace Villa Long-Term Care Facility

Attached to the Fort St. John Hospital is the 124 bed Peace Villa Long-Term Care Facility. Recreation programming that is engaging the residents with and in the community is on the rise, a thriving junior volunteer program is connecting generations together, and a sense of home is being built to support the residents not only physically, but mentally and emotionally.

Northern Health offers a wide variety of community health services, ranging from mental health and substance use services and supports, to home support and respite

services, community nutrition and dietitian services and community rehabilitation services. Population and Public Health services include immunizations, communicable disease prevention and control, and harm reduction services, among many others. And Environmental Health Officers safeguard the well-being of both the public and the environment by educating people about public health issues, monitoring and inspecting regulated facilities and enforcing health legislation.

**The Regional Hospital District** contributes the regional share of capital costs toward major health care construction projects and minor capital and equipment purchases, of providing approved health care facilities, and other grants in the region.

**North Peace Division of Family Practice** represents private practice family physicians of Fort St. John and Hudson's Hope with an office in Fort St. John. Together, the members work to improve patient access to local primary care, increase local physicians' influence on health care delivery and policy, and provide professional support for physicians.

The Division gives local physicians an opportunity to work collaboratively with Northern Health, the GPSC, and the Ministry of Health to identify health care needs in the community and develop solutions to meet those needs.

The Division's work has resulted in improved access to family physicians as well as changed how appointments are booked within physician offices; formerly most appointments had to be pre-booked in advance however this changed to having some pre-scheduled appointments along with a number of same day appointments - so that if you wake up in the morning and you or your child is sick then you are more easily able to get in to see your/a doctor in your clinic that day which can be more responsive to patient's health care needs.

Fort St. John and area residents can also call the Northern Health Virtual Primary and Community Care Clinic which provides services to people who don't have a family doctor or nurse practitioner, people who need care on weekends after their health centre is closed, or who are unable to travel for care due to seasonal weather. (You're encouraged to call your family doctor or nurse practitioner first, when possible). The Virtual Clinic also provides support for mental health and substance use. Patients can call the Virtual Clinic at 1-844-645-7811, to access a family doctor or nurse practitioner 10 am to 10 pm daily PST (including weekends and statutory holidays).

### Supporting Health Services

Fort St. John is also home to a number of private community health services including dental clinics, optometry, physiotherapy clinics, pharmacists, first aid training centres, private ambulance and first aid services.

## Partners in Health Care

### Fort St. John Child Development Centre

The Child Development Centre supports children, families, and communities in an inclusive environment through innovative programs and services. Their purpose is to aid children with special needs and assist with early childhood education. They specialize in physiotherapy, speech-language pathology, occupational therapy, family services, respite/skills, and integrated infant and preschool development programs.

### Fort St. John Hospital Foundation

The Fort St. John Hospital Foundation in partnership with community members, local business and corporations, supports the hospital and Peace Villa long-term care facility with the purchase of state-of-the-art medical equipment and more, through the generosity of its donors and supporters. Ensuring our hospital has access to the best medical equipment the Foundation reduces the need to travel out of the region for medical treatment. ### MRI BODY COIL

With the arrival of the MRI Body Coil our medical imaging department now has improved diagnostic capabilities. The MRI Body Coil provides a vast improvement in image quality that will increase the chance of early discovery of malignancies and in turn will allow for early treatment options for patients.



### HEALTH CARE WORKERS

The FSJ Hospital Foundation has been supporting continuing education of local healthcare workers since 1997, through our educational grant program. # OIL & GAS

Known as the "Energetic City" Fort St. John is the service and support centre for the oil and natural gas industry in the Peace Region.



## **Oil & Gas remains a strong economic driver in the Peace Region as operations continue to grow.**

The Montney Formation is one of the largest known oil and gas resources in the world, and stretches from Northwest Alberta into the Peace Region and north towards Fort Nelson. The Montney Formation is rich in oil and natural gas liquids like ethane, propane and butane, which makes investment in the exploration, extraction and processing of the region's oil and gas more economically viable. The total estimated resources found in the formation could support national output for 145 years.

Today, hundreds of large and small pipelines, well site construction, trucking and seismic companies are at work in the region providing direct employment opportunities for thousands of workers, and crucial support to a demanding industry.

Support for the industry is provided at a government level. The industry's regulatory body, the British Columbia Energy Regulator (Previously the BC Oil and Gas Commission) is headquartered in Fort St. John. The BCER is responsible for regulating oil and

gas and geothermal operations in British Columbia. The BCER protects public safety and safeguards the environment through the sound regulation of oil, gas and geothermal activities in BC. From exploration through to final reclamation, the BCER works closely with First Nations, land owners and rights holders, and ensures industry complies with provincial legislation. With more than 20 years' dedicated service, the regulator is committed to safe and responsible energy resource management for British Columbia.

Directional and horizontal drilling and multi-well pads used in unconventional gas development are reducing the footprints of new developments as they provide opportunities for enhanced planning and shared surface structures.

As the resource potential of these areas continues to grow and industry shifts from land acquisition to gas extraction, expanded infrastructure will be required for development, production, processing and transportation of natural gas.

The Peace Region continues to lead the way in the Oil & Gas industry as the base of operations for the province.

## The petroleum industry has had a lengthy history in British Columbia. Exploration for oil began at the turn of the last century.

It wasn't until the 1950's that development of natural gas began in the northeast of the province. When the first gas pipeline was completed from the Peace River District to Vancouver in 1957, gas began to flow south for both domestic and export consumption.

Today, hundreds of large and small pipelines, well site construction, trucking and seismic companies are at work in the region providing crucial support to a demanding industry.

## The history of oil and gas development in British Columbia extends back to the 1800's, and it got it's start right here in the Peace Region more than 100 years ago.

### 1889

A railway company looking for coal drilled a hole at Haney on the Fraser River near Pitt Meadows and reported a violent gas blow at a depth of 60 feet.

### 1889

Port Haney No. 1 well was drilled adjacent to the railway well, above, and encounters "marsh gas" at a depth of 193 feet.

### 1906

The first officially recorded well was drilled; the Steveston No. 1, in the Fraser River delta. This was abandoned at a depth of 1,200 feet.

### 1910

Muir Creek No. 1, Sooke area. The well was abandoned at a depth of 1,560 feet. A second Sooke well was drilled before 1920 on Whiffin Spit, total depth was 2,000 feet.

### 1920

The British Columbia government drills five or six test holes in the Peace River area, just west of the Townships.

These were not intended for completion or production.

### Early 1930's

The B.C. government places all lands in the Peace River area under a drilling reserve.

### 1941

The British Columbia government drills a test hole near Pine Pass.

### Christmas Eve, 1947

Spudding of the first successful gas well in British Columbia — the Peace River Natural Gas No. 1.

This was a Cadotte gas well, and eventually flowed gas at 600 to 1200 mcf/day.

## The oil and gas industry is evolving, and so has the training of its workers.

Working in **partnership with Tourmaline Oil**, Northern Lights College created the **Field Operations Specialist — Hydrocarbon Resources (FOS-HR) program** to ensure the field operators of the future would be well prepared to work in the industry.

With a combined 130 years of experience, subject matter experts from both NLC and Tourmaline worked together to create the modules for the program.



The first cohort of the FOS-HR pilot saw eight students in the classroom and the field operations lab at the NLC Fort St. John campus. All of those students went on to work full time for Tourmaline.

# LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

LNG efforts are continuing to grow across our province and nation - many companies see the potential of exports from BC to Asia and multiple investors across the natural gas sector have expressed interest in developing LNG facilities on BC's northwest coast.

**Natural gas activities have been taking place in British Columbia since the early 1950s. The northeast region of the province is where most natural gas resources can be found – predominantly from the Montney Basin and Horn River Basin. Once produced, the natural gas from these basins may then be shipped via connecting pipelines to LNG facilities for processing.**

The availability of these liquids increase the economic viability associated with the exploration, extraction and processing of the region's natural gas resource.

The province has announced three new LNG energy projects as of April 2025:

The Cedar LNG project is a \$4 billion dollar partnership in Kitimat between the Haisla First Nation and the Pembina Pipeline Corporation. The facility is expected to produce 3.3 million tonnes of liquefied natural gas per year.

The Northeast BC Connector Project is a proposed twin pipeline designed to bring condensates and natural gas liquids from Wonowon across the border into Alberta.

Enbridge is slated to begin construction of a Northeastern expansion to the BC Pipeline, which stretches almost 3,000 kilometres from Northeast BC to the lower mainland. The planned expansion to the T-North site will increase delivery by 179 cubic feet-per-day, and will provide a critical route out of the Montney basin.

# COAL MINING

**The Peace Region is situated along a rich mineral layer of coal, stretching through the eastern flank of the Rocky Mountains. Our area contains a high concentration of metallurgical coal, an essential fuel and reactant used in steelmaking.**

Conuma Resources is making substantial investments into the mining industry at multiple major mining sites in the Peace Region. The Quintette Mine in Tumbler Ridge has been acquired by Conuma Resources after a 24 year hiatus, and mine operations restarted in 2024.

The Quintette mine is now Conuma's largest steelmaking coal operation. More than 1.5 million work hours and an estimated \$500 million dollars were invested in modernizing the historical

mining site, including the installation of a new 5.2 km gravity-fed conveyor, new processing modules, and a modern mining fleet.

The Quintette Coal Mine originally opened in 1982 and operated for 18 years, until its closure in 2000. The community of Tumbler Ridge was a planned community built to support the mine.

Conuma Resources is estimated to employ more than 400 workers with the current scale of Quintette operations.

In 2024, Conuma Resources also acquired the Trend-Roman Mine in the Tumbler Ridge area. The mine has been closed since 2014 but represents another high-quality mining opportunity for Conuma and the residents of the Peace Region.

# HYDROELECTRIC



Hydroelectric in the Peace Region generates an average of **18,200 Gigawatt hours** per year - **40%** of BC Hydro's total power generation.

The hydroelectric industry is a significant part of the energy sector in the Peace Region. Our area is home to several hydroelectric projects, including the W.A.C. Bennett Dam, the Peace Canyon Dam, and the Site C Dam. These projects provide clean and renewable energy to British Columbia and support the province's commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

The W.A.C. Bennett Dam, located on the Peace River, is one of the largest hydroelectric dams in North America, with a generating capacity of 2,730 megawatts. The

dam has been in operation since 1968 and has provided clean and renewable energy to British Columbia for over 57 years. The Peace Canyon Dam, located downstream from the W.A.C. Bennett Dam, has a generating capacity of 695 megawatts and has been in operation since 1980.

The Site C Dam, now complete on the Peace River, is expected to provide clean and renewable energy to British Columbia for over a century. The dam will have a generating capacity of 1,100 megawatts once all the main generators are online, and

will be able to power an estimated 500,000 homes per year.

Overall, the hydroelectric industry is an important part of the energy sector in the Peace Region of Northeastern British Columbia.

Many believe that as the region continues to grow and develop, the hydroelectric industry will play an important role in meeting the energy needs of the province while balancing environmental and community concerns.



## BC HYDRO SITE 'C' DAM 2025 UPDATE

As of April 2025, four of the 6 planned generation stations are online, putting two-thirds of the project's generating capacity operational. Each generation station is capable of generating more than 180 megawatts of electricity - enough to power about 80,000 homes. Once all 6 generation stations are online, the project will provide enough power to increase BC Hydro's electricity supply by eight percent.

The filled reservoir is now 83 kilometres long - two to three times the original width of the river. New boat launches along the river are being built and will be accessible by the public, but remain closed until the reservoir has been deemed safe.

# WIND POWER

Four large wind facilities are in full operation across the North Peace region, producing an estimated total of 570+ MW.

## Two new Wind Power projects were announced in 2025:

The Stewart Creek Wind Project is a partnership between West Moberly First Nations and Innergex. The project is expected to come online in 2030 and produce an additional 200 MW.

The Taylor Wind Project is a partnership between Saulteau First Nations and EDF Renewables. The project is expected to come online in 2031 and produce an estimated 200 MW.

The Bear Mountain Wind Park is an electricity generating wind farm facility located near Dawson Creek. It is owned by Bear Mountain Wind LP and began operations in November, 2009. BC's first operating wind farm has a generating capacity of 102 megawatts.

Meikle Wind near Tumbler Ridge is a 180 MW wind energy generation project with 61 GE wind turbines. The project has the annual energy capacity equal to the needs of approximately 54,000 British Columbian homes.

The Dokie Ridge Wind Farm is a wind farm located near Chetwynd. It was put into commercial operation in 2011. The facility has a generating capacity of 144 megawatts and is producing 320 to 340 gigawatt-hours of energy per year.

Capital Power's 142 megawatt (MW) Quality Wind facility located near Tumbler Ridge, began commercial operation on November 6, 2012, on time and under budget. The project involved the installation of 79 Vestas V90 and V100 wind turbines, which produces 1.8 MW of power. The project generates enough clean electricity to meet the average annual needs of about 43,000 homes.

These are all Independent power producer projects, feeding clean wind power into the BC grid under contract with BC Hydro. The future of the wind industry in the Peace is bright, with over 10,000 MW of wind energy potential waiting for development.

# AGRICULTURE

**The Peace Region is classified as a prairie and Canada's most northern agricultural region.**

Long before any oil exploration took place, the North Peace was largely populated by farmers. In fact, Fort St. John's downtown was once part of a farm owned by Clark Mackenzie Finch, whose name adorns one of the elementary schools in the city.

The Peace Region lays claim to almost **11.5 million acres** of agricultural land - **27% of BC's total Agricultural Reserve**. An estimated **1,532 farms and ranches** are located throughout our region.

Located on the only prairie in BC, The Peace Region is filled with fertile farmland, which **produces most the province's grains**, including canola, barley, oats and wheat,

and supports a thriving livestock industry. Farms located along river valleys also produce field crops that grow well in shorter seasons, like root vegetables, peas, cabbage and sweet corn. The livestock grown in the region ranges from beef and dairy cattle, to bison, ostriches, chickens, hogs and sheep.

In addition, an increasing number of smaller farmers produce organically certified meat and produce. Much of this product is sold direct to the public through local Farmer's Markets and the Peace Region Farmer's Institute. The Butcher Block, located in Fort St. John and Dawson Creek sells locally produced meat including sought-after Hutterite turkeys from the South Peace Colony.
